## **Routine Exam Room Cleaning Checklist**

The following steps should be taken by practice staff for routine cleaning of exam rooms after each patient whether the patient is fully clothed throughout the visit or not. (Also, encourage patients to use hand sanitizer upon arrival and before leaving exam room.)

Perform	hand	hygiene	and	don	gloves.
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□ Remove the linen/paper covering on the exam table,

Wipe down exam table with hospital approved disinfectant wipes and allow to air dry per manufacture's instructions on container.

□ If pillow is used, disposable covers must be used and changed after every patient.

Use hospital approved disinfectant to thoroughly wipe down all non-disposable equipment that touch patients and allow to air dry per manufacturer's instruction on container. This includes but is not limited to:

- □ Blood pressure cuff/vital sign stand
- □ Stethoscope
- Otoscope
- □ Thermometer
- Oximeter (use alcohol swab, not disinfectant wipes)
- Other

Use hospital approved disinfectant to thoroughly wipe down all high touch surfaces such that have been touched by the patient and/or gloved (contaminated) staff and allow to air dry per manufacturer's instructions on container. This includes but is not limited to:

- □ All horizontal surfaces (countertops and tables)
- □ Chairs
- □ Telephones
- □ Keyboards, mouse, WOW
- Door handles
- Other

Follow practice guidelines to indicate room and/or equipment has been cleaned/disinfected.

□ Remove gloves and perform hand hygiene
